

INTEGRATION OF JAPANESE COMMUNITY IN BRAZIL AFTER WORLD WAR II

Abstract: *Brazil is home to the world's largest Japanese community outside of Japan. Current study aims to determine the integration degree of Brazilian Nikkei by following its dynamics and taking into account its main measuring markers. Special attention is paid to the factors influencing the integration processes, as well as to the applicability of the "Japanese case in Brazil" to the theoretical framework. The study is an attempt for contemporary analytical rationalization and supplementation to the available historiography.*
