

ENVIRONMENTAL CHALLENGES FOR COASTAL FORMATIONS BY THE NAVY FORCES

Abstract: *Environmental problems with solid waste and their management in the coastal zone and the marine environment in the middle are increasingly playing a role in the formation of measures and activities for their regulation. These problems also apply to military formations of the Navy, which pose a risk to the health of the specific composition and presentation of the surrounding ecological systems. The present study aims to assess the amount of marine solid waste in coastal areas near areas for deployment of naval formations, as well as their classifications and percentage in relation to the Black Sea beaches. Measures and solutions are proposed to reduce the subsequent impact and accumulation of solid waste around the dislocation and coastal areas.*

The study is based on data from the Basin Directorate-Black Sea Region and data collected by the author.
